A DIFFERENT JOURNEY

THE TEST

I learned from my parents to appreciate the natural beauty of birds and flowers, butterflies and trees. But I began to doubt other things they taught me. I thought I could go solo in life and do whatever I wanted. I began to test everything, to ask questions and to look for evidence. I became a biomedical scientist.

I could see my parents were right about the natural world but I questioned whether they were right about the spiritual world and the Christian faith. I doubted whether God existed. Could Jesus Christ really offer HOPE and purpose? I needed evidence. A second-hand faith was of no use to me.

THE DISCOVERY

I wanted to know if Jesus was truly a historical figure who lived, died on a cross and came back to life. With a scientific interest and an open mind I began to read the eye witness accounts in the Bible. When I read that God is like a good Father, I needed clear evidence that He is good. I found what I was looking for in reliable records about Jesus. As I researched further, I understood more about God's LOVE for me through the life of Jesus. I discovered that Jesus is who He claims to be, the Saviour of the world.

I found that God has revealed himself as a LOVING Father through Jesus.

THE DECISION

I turned away from my independent, me-first lifestyle and asked Jesus to choose the direction for my life. I began to serve others willingly. Now He sets the agenda. I can honestly say I have no regrets about starting this new and purposeful life. You can throw this leaflet away but before you do ... Permit me to ask: Have you looked at the evidence for Jesus?

A DIFFERENT KIND OF LAUGHTER

FROM MOCKERY

I wonder what makes you laugh. I laughed when I heard my cousin and her partner had become Christians. They had been taking cocaine and now I thought they had become weirdly religious. I laughed but I wasn't laughing with HOPE for them. Instead I mocked them, especially when I told friends at work.

My cousin wrote to invite me to spend Christmas together. She mentioned in the letter: "God loves you". More laughter at my work. However, I didn't laugh when I arrived at their home. Was I too "polite" to laugh in their face? I don't know but my attitude soon changed. I was surprised by the tender LOVING care they now had for each other. It wasn't just them – I was impressed by the LOVE of their new friends. I had never experienced

anything like this. They had one thing in common - Jesus had changed them all.

THROUGH QUESTIONS

I asked my cousin question after question that week. Some questions were serious, others still half-mocking. She spoke of how God LOVED me so much that He sent His Son, Jesus, to die in my place so that I could be forgiven. Towards the end of the visit she asked if she could pray with me. I accepted the offer. While they were praying, I knew I needed to be forgiven. God was present and I asked Him to forgive me and change me.

TO A NEW LAUGH

I returned to my work. When my friends asked how I had got on at Christmas, I had some explaining to do. Some laughed at me but they could not deny the good changes in me and I could not deny what God was doing in my life. I started to be honest both in my speech and in my work. There was one change they could not help but hear - I had a new laugh, an unusual laugh that I still have today - some say my laughter lightens up the room.

Along with Christian friends, we continue to learn to LOVE like Jesus and to bring HOPE to others.
